SPECIAL SERVICES

The City of Dunnellon offers special pick up service for household goods, appliances, tires, and bulk yard waste. Please call 352-465-8590 to arrange for service and fees. The fees will be charged to your regular monthly utility bill.

***YARD WASTE**

Requirements for picking up yard waste are that loose debris(leaves, etc) be bagged not to exceed 50 lbs., limbs no longer than 4’ (four feet,) and 6” (six inches) in diameter.

Maximum pick up is 2 yards per visit.

****RECYCLING**

The City of Dunnellon also offers a recycling program. Times listed on the back of this brochure. See inset for a list of specific items acceptable for recycling. Pick up containers at the Public Services office: 11924 Bostick St in Dunnellon.

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM

Acceptable materials are as follows:

PLASTIC

Containers marked 1 through 7 on the bottom.
No plastic wrap, detergent bottles, grocery bags.

PAPER

Newspapers, newspaper inserts, magazines, catalogs, paper grocery bags, corrugated cardboard boxes, cereal boxes, telephone books, printer paper, copier paper, junk mail, milk & juice cartons, any clean fiber material that can be torn.

GLASS

Clear, brown, and green glass bottles and jars.
No glass that is not a container, light bulbs, plate glass, mirrors, china, or ceramics.

ALUMINUM

Beer and soft drink cans.
No steel or metal containers of any type. **No** aluminum foils or pie plates.

STEEL CANS

Soup, vegetable, and pet food cans.
No paint cans, aerosol cans, scrap metal.

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED

Microwave glass trays, mirrors, window or auto glass, light bulbs, ceramics, porcelain glass cookware/bake ware, unnumbered plastics, plastic bags, coat hangers

**ALL RECYCLABLES CAN BE COMBINED
INTO ONE BIN. PLEASE RINSE
CONTAINERS, UNCAP BOTTLES, AND
FLATTEN CONTAINERS AND BOXES.**
